Fun Fair will offer full breakfast for stall holders should they require it. **Ring Entertainment.** Dave has spoken to St. Lawrence PTA for suggestion from them for ideas. He will keep in touch with Debbie Scarborough on this. He also spoke to The Holt school, and they will get back to him. Dave has also spoken to the Theatre school who said they will do a performance in the ring. Lee Frecklington has also been approached to do something with a football game. Dave suggested ring activities should be from 2pm to 4pm with a finale of Bale Tossing. Chris Goldson agreed, and a list and times of programme events will be put around the ring fence. Flypast time has yet to be confirmed. Volunteers will be needed throughout the afternoon and also for clearing away. Sophie Bennett has offered her service for clearing up.


