Officers from North Kesteven Environmental Health unannounced visits :

24 June 2022

Visited on Friday 24 June at about 1pm, Parked at the Village Hall, no odour detected. Visited a resident along Lincoln Road, no odour detected during this meeting.

27 June 2022

Visited on Monday 27th June at about 12.15pm. Very cloudy and slight breeze at Gardenfield. Started to drizzle and stayed for 10 minutes. Drove up to Magpie Close, again very cloudy and raining harder. No smell noted all. Left at 12:31 and drove up to Queensway. Pouring down and really windy, no smell noted. Left at 12:40 and drove up past Hughes and a lorry, but couldn't note any smell from that. Intensity at all sites 0 and Offensiveness at all sites 0.
