**STREET LIGHTING**

Cllr Richardson gave an overview of the current position with Street Lighting in the village that the Parish Council is responsible for. This has been a ongoing problem for some time, especially with the lights around the path leading to the Church these currently are not working, and the problems to replace these including that the lights are on a local farmers land. Cllr Richardson had asked three companies to quote for repairs, and had received two to which he had brought to the meeting.

There was a general discussion, on size of lights, wattage etc. The cost of the two quotes etc. Councillors wished to vote at this meeting to ensure the work goes ahead as soon as possible.

Council proposed and seconded to go ahead with Selmec, but asked Cllr Richardson to check on the provision of different bulb sizing which may alter the quotation and also to write to the Landowner for permission to go onto land for work to be completed, this to be done before placing the order
