### **Skellingthorpe Gala 2023**

Chair advised that due to the fact that it is now only 4 months to the proposed Gala date, and nothing had been organised, of which organisation normally starts in August/September of the year before the gala, Skellingthorpe Gala 2023 would not go ahead due to lack of time and assistance. There followed a discussion on volunteers, and Councillors involvement with the organisation of such a big event. This lead to other events held over the year such as 50/61, where all Councillors should attend and mingle with visitors, making conversation with them.

### **King Charles Coronation event**

Chair advised this would be on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> May and will be held in the Car park and not on the Monson Playing Field. This will then sort out any problems should the weather be inclement where the Community Centre could be used, also giving access to Toilets. A budget had been previously agreed of £1,000. This event was based on it being a Children and Family Event with Party Workshop booked to entertain children with a circus theme. Party Worksop would also provide background music. Mickey and Minnie would be asked to attend. Daisy Made would check if the van would be available to sell Ice Cream, or if this was not available Dave Scarborough advised he could look into providing Ice Cream that can be given to the children along with Jelly that Christine Goldson was organising (although Christine was not in attendance at this meeting she had advised previously she would look into the provision of Jelly). Cllr Coyle-Fox would be getting weather reports on the phone around 10 days before the event, should it be forecasted to be extremely bad weather which may need the event to be cancelled with information given out in advance and not last minute.

Christine was looking into extra funds that might be available from NKDC. Lynda (RFO) had purchased a Coronation Mug for every child in the village that attends the primary and nursery schools in Skellingthorpe.

M Rouston (clerk) asked about the Scouts, who are planning to build a Scout Cart for their 100 year anniversary, and had previously asked about opening the Gala with this, could we ask the scouts to come to Kings Coronation event to "open" the event with their cart, and possibly do a Recruitment Drive for Scouts along with Beavers, Squirrels etc. as this would be a childrens event. Volunteers for the Kings Coronation Event are full and no more volunteers required for this event.

It was proposed to not go ahead with this event at this time with All in favour

Other than 50/61 Memorial event and Remembrance Day, it was decided that there would be no further events organised for 2023.
