3.Insignia: Inspected.

4.Approve Minutes from 30th January 2024, closed session included. LF queried Item 12 regarding Speedwatch. Following this the minutes were proposed and seconded as a true record of that meeting with All in Favour. **Motion Carried.**

5.Chair Report: CCF spoke of the carparking issue at the Co-op store, with the potholes now mended but the issue with a new bollard had been misunderstood, and she would report again next meeting on the situation. Skellingthorpe roundabout issues, Greg from Highways England still has not got back to us, so she will chase on this.

6.Clerks Report: None

7.Accounts: AW queried the Gallaghers Insurance with LS giving the answers regarding the full coverage under our insurance. From this it was proposed and seconded to accept the accounts with all in favour. **Motion Carried.**

8.Report from District & LCC Councillors. None Received

9.Community Centre Update. The CC Management Committee meeting was held 20th February the bookings are going well, and the accounts are looking healthy, despite having to have professional work done to comply with health and safety regulations. Electrics are now all correct New Cooker has been installed. It was reported that there was no Fire Alarm or Smoke detectors in the building Reports and estimates are now being complied. Floor renovations is now on hold until next year, but grants are being applied for to assist with this. Discussion on the problem of the roof over the kitchen door, and Dave Buttler has cleared the gutters, and working alongside Tritton Roofing to get this work completed.

b.Events Update. The gala was discussed. Quite a few stalls have already booked, looking at more types of entertainment.

c.Planning. February meeting was a lengthy one, with residents from the Old Wood coming to speak about Chestnut Farm where there was retrospective planning for 15 Industrial Units along with an application from adjacent Beechwood House. They were advised to contact NKDC with their facts, as although SKPC would object it was the decision of NKDC only to accept or reject.

LF made a comment on a complaint regarding property on Jerusalem Road where the owner is working weekends and evening with building works and noise. It was agreed that there was no jurisdiction regarding this.

d.106 Update: Council looked at AW's drawing of a Concept idea and GB spoke on two phases on this, Phase 1 to be completed first with Phase 2 to be completed when more funds are received. Maria has now received a brief. Discussion on storage not to have this in the building but to retain the current containers. There followed a discussion on quotes for demolishing the existing pavilion these just to give an idea on costs. Must be aware of the possibilities of Asbestos.

Chair asked MS about Skate Park Progress and was advised that the Public Consultation had a good turnout and feedback. There were some comments made to which Matt of Wheelscape will be altering, then a further public consultation to show these and with the possibility to go the Planning from there possible 2 weeks' time.


10. Speedwatch Update
